Statistics

Year 8 to Year 12 Apparent Retention Rates for St Mary's College. These rates have been calculated using the nationally agreed methodology which is defined as the number of full-time students in Year 12 in any given year, expressed as a percentage of the number of students enrolled in Year 8 at the school five years previously.

The calculations are based on enrolment data collected from the school by the Commonwealth Department of Education Science and Training (DEST) as part of the annual National School Statistics Collection.

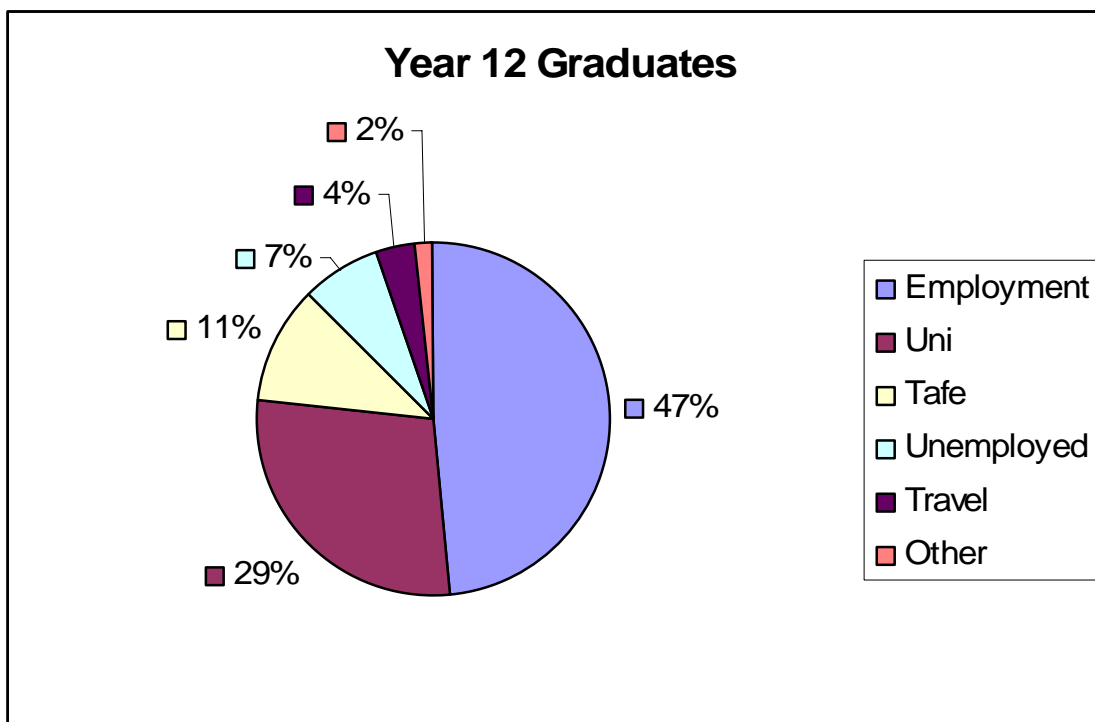
