Queensland University of Technology Economics Schools Day

On Friday 21st July, the Year 11 and 12 Economics classes will be travelling to the Queensland University of Technology to participate in their annual Schools Day, hosted by the School of Economics.

In addition to an opportunity to visit the QUT campus, the day is invaluable in that students are exposed to a range of experiences to deepen their understanding of the current economic state of play. On the day, presentations are conducted by current QUT economics lecturers and encompass current economic data, information relevant to topics being studied/researched as well as future career opportunities.
